Engage (15 min)	 T writes the sentence "If I had a lot of money, I would buy a robot" on the bb T invites Ss to drill the structure T elicits the form of conditional type 2 from the sentence and writes it on the bb IF CLAUSE (if + S + simple past), MAIN CLAUSE (S+ would + verb (inf)) Ss compare between conditional type 2 and the other types of conditionals they learnt before T elicits the use of conditional type 2 by giving prompts: "do I have a lot of money?" "Can I buy a robot?"
